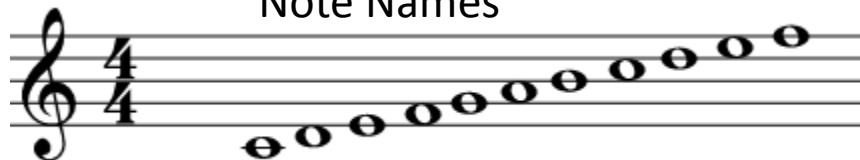

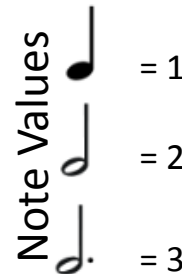
Now that you have done Task 1, go to keyboards and see if you can recognise the piece _____
